### BACKGROUND:

On 26th January 1950, we adopted and gave ourselves a written Constitution that assured equality to all. Thus, the Constitution became the cornerstone of our Nation and basic vision document for all the endeavors of the State. The Constitution of India has laid down the powers of the different organs of the State and its relation to its citizens. The citizens are assured certain Fundamental Rights which are in conformity with the Universal Declaration of Human Rights. The State cannot make any laws that violate the Fundamental Rights of the citizens. However, the conflicts between various stakeholders are bound to arise. Such conflicts have been adjudicated by the Supreme Court of India by interpreting the Constitution. The Supreme Court has been hailed as the guardian of the Constitution and Fundamental Rights in India. The philosophy of 'Constitutionalism' has saved the Constitution from being distorted for selfish ends of vested interests.

In the past six decades, Constitution has undergone a lot of evolution. The first decade became a witness to the struggle of the Nehru Government in implementing the agrarian and land reform legislations amidst the opposition by the Judiciary. In the second decade, the squabble between the Judiciary and the Parliament continued. In the third decade, the debate of supremacy between Judiciary and Parliament culminated in the landmark decision of Kesavananda Bharathi case. The Supreme Court was criticized for its lack of commitment for Fundamental Rights and Liberty in the ADM Jabalpur case during the dark age of emergency. Post-emergency, the Supreme Court took up the progressive step of Judicial Activism and expanded the Fundamental Rights by giving a wider interpretation and was hailed as the last resort for those affected with injustice. There have been criticisms also, that the Supreme Court has often usurped into the territory of the Parliament, Executive and dictated policy issues.

### OBJECTIVES OF THE CONFERENCE:

- To review Constitutional vision and philosophy in formulating inclusive growth and development;
- To assess the role of Constitution in advocating distributive and corrective justice;
- To re-asses the Constitutional & legislative reforms in implementing inclusive development; and
- To suggest new strategies and tools for making inclusive social, economic and political justice accessible to the common man.

### Sub themes:




