





### Report on NAAC Training

An orientation programme on the topic "The Revised NAAC Guidelines and Responsibilities of IQAC" was conducted for the Faculty members and the non-teaching staff on 16/03/2020. Dr V Sudesh, Dean & Principal, ULC, Bangalore University & Invitee Member of the Governing Council of Vivekananda College of Law oriented us on the revised assessment and accreditation framework of NAAC. In his address he stated that the following matters be kept in mind. The extensive use of Information & Communication Technology for scalability and robustness and as a quality improvement tool should be compulsorily incorporated into teaching. The active participation of students and alumni in all the activities of the institution should be enhanced. The IQAC in its periodic meetings to focus on the achievement of vision, mission, institutional goals and objectives and ensure the effective execution of the same. To chart out the calendar of events and ensure the conduct of sufficient number of programmes for a particular academic year.

Extension and outreach activities should promote community involvement and development. To encourage the teachers to pursue higher education and research activities and to publish research papers.

The institution to regularly take stock of augmenting infrastructure and physical facilities for conducive learning. The institution to facilitate wide faculty members, non teaching staff and students representation and engagement in various activities. To concentrate on the institutional values and best practices to uphold institutional distinctiveness. To encourage the teachers to pursue higher education and research activities and to publish research papers. To concentrate on the outcomes of the course and specific programmes conducted in the institution. To facilitate faculty exchange programmes.

The orientation programme proved to be highly informative and beneficial in enhancing the knowledge in understanding the amended guidelines in NAAC. ### Report on Orientation programme to conduct online class

The outbreak of COVID-19 pandemic was a bolt from the blue for us and sent shock waves and fear down us with uncertainty about the future. The National lockdown added to this apprehension. This led to contemplation about the continuance of education and prevention of loss of precious time. The Principal instructed the faculty members to explore possibilities of online teaching through audio clippings and Youtube videos. The announcement of National lockdown with immediate effect had not prepared us to teach from home even as we were grappling with ways and means of reaching out to students. The silver lining was the Whats app class groups that had been created. To ensure that the classroom environment should be created for online teaching, the Principal urged the faculty members to explore online platforms for conducting regular classes as per the timetable. The faculty members in an online meeting with the Principal opined that classes can be effectively conducted through the Zoom platform. With consensus from all teachers the Principal informed all the faculty members to schedule and hold regular classes as per the timetable. The teachers were delighted that the online classes were quite successful with most of the students joining the class sessions. However free Zoom class could be conducted only for forty minutes, after which it immediately ended. Students were reluctant to rejoin the class for the second time for another twenty minutes.

Our parent body, Janatha Education Society, Bengaluru, appointed Sri Vijaykumar as Technical Head and Nodal Officer. He was informed by the management to give training to all the faculty members for holding regular classes for one hour per class as per the timetable. He scheduled an orientation programme for teachers and non teaching staff on 5/5/2020 to facilitate the smooth conduct of all classes for an hour duration each. He advised the download of Moodle App to schedule online classes and hold them regularly.

A separate Whatsapp group of staff members of both teaching and non teaching was created for submission of work diary of teachers along with students attendance of every class. The non teaching staff were instructed by the Principal to consolidate these reports for onward transmissions to the management.

This orientation programme was a boon to the faculty members, empowering them in efficiently holding classes amidst the lockdown.


