⇒ FIR → First Information Report.

⇒ What is an FIR → First Information Report [FIR] is a written document prepared by the police when they receive information about the commission of a cognizable offence. It is a report of information that reaches the police first in point of time and that is why it is called the First Information Report.

It is generally a complaint lodged with the police by the victim of a cognizable offence or by someone on his/her behalf.

Anyone can report the commission of a cognizable offence either orally or in writing to the police. Even a telephonic message can be treated as an FIR.

⇒ Cognizable offence :- A cognizable offence is one in which the police may arrest a person without warrant. They are authorised to start investigation into a cognizable case on their own and do not require any orders from the court to do so.

⇒ Non - Cognizable offence :- A non-cognizable offence is an offence in which a police officer has no authority to arrest without warrant. The police

investigate such an offence without the court's permission.

⇒ Why is FIR important?

An FIR is a very important document as it sets the process of criminal justice in motion. It is only after the FIR is registered in the police station that the police takes up investigation of the case.

⇒ Who can lodge an FIR?

Anyone who knows about the commission of a cognizable offence can file an FIR. It is not necessary that only the victim of the crime should file an FIR. A police officer who comes to know about a cognizable offence can file an FIR himself/herself.

You can file an FIR if:

1. You are the person against whom the offence has been committed;
2. You know yourself about an offence which has been committed;
3. You have seen the offence being committed.
4. Witnesses, if any.

⇒ Things you should NOT do:

1. Never file a false complaint or give wrong information to the police. You can be prosecuted under law for giving wrong information or for misleading the police.

[Section 203, Indian Penal Code 1860]

2. Never exaggerate or distort facts.

3. Never make vague or unclear statements.

⇒ What can you do if your FIR is not registered?

1. You can meet the Superintendent of police or other higher officers like Deputy Inspector General of police and Inspector General of police and bring your complaint to their notice.

2. You can send your complaint in writing and by post to the Superintendent of police concerned. If the Superintendent of police is satisfied with your complaint, he shall either investigate the case himself or order an investigation to be made.

3. You can file a private complaint before the court having jurisdiction.

4. You can also make a complaint to the State Human Rights Commission or the National Human Rights Commission if the police does nothing to enforce the law or does it in a biased and corrupt manner.

The police may not investigate a complaint even if you file a FIR, when;

- (i) The case is not serious in nature;
- (ii) The police feel that there is not enough ground to investigate.

However, the police must record the reasons for not conducting an investigation and in the latter case must also inform you.

- [Section 157, Criminal Procedure Code 1973]

⇒ What is the procedure of filing an FIR?

The procedure of filing an FIR is prescribed in Section 154 of the Criminal Procedure Code, 1973.

1. When information about the commission of a cognizable offence is given orally, the police must write it down.
2. It is your right as a person giving information or making a complaint to demand that the information recorded by the police is read over to you.
3. Once the information has been recorded by the police, it must be signed by the person giving the information.

RTI

Right to Information

Right to Information Act, 2005 :-

The Right to Information [RTI] is an act of the Parliament of India which sets out the rules and procedures regarding citizen's right to information. It replaced the former Freedom of Information Act, 2002. Under the provisions of RTI Act, any citizen of # India may request information from a "public authority" which is required to reply expeditiously or within is required to reply expeditiously or within thirty days. In case of matter involving a petitioner's life and liberty, the information has to be provided within 48 hours. The Act also requires every public authority to computerize their records for wide dissemination and to proactively publish certain categories of information so that the citizens need minimum recourse to request for information formally.

* How to File RTI?

Every Indian should know about RTI filing. The procedure to ~~to~~ File RTI is simple and hassle-free.

① Write the application [or get it typed, your choice] on a paper in English/Hindi/the official language of the state. Some states have prescribed format for RTI applications. Address it to the PIO [Public Information officer] of the department concerned.

② Ask specific questions. See to it that they are clear and complete, and not confusing whatsoever.

③ Write your full name, contact details and address, where you want the information/response to your RTI be sent.

④ Take a photocopy of the application for your record. If you're sending the application by post, it's advisable to send it via registered post, as then you will have an acknowledgement of your request's delivery. If you're submitting the application to the PIO in person, remember to take an acknowledgement from him/her.
