An ounce of mediation is worth a pound of arbitration and a ton of litigation.

### WHAT IS MEDIATION

Mediation is a voluntary, binding process in which an impartial and neutral mediator facilitates disputing parties in reaching a settlement. A mediator does not impose a solution but creates a conducive environment in which disputing parties can resolve all their disputes.

Mediation is tried and tested alternative method of dispute resolution. It has proved to be a great success in the cities of Delhi, Ranchi, Jamshedpur, Nagpur, Chandigarh and Aungmye.

Litigants participating in the mediation process have unequivocally endorsed it.

Mediation is:-

- \* A Structured process where a neutral person uses specialized communication and negotiation techniques
- \* A process of facilitating parties in resolving their disputes
- \* A Settlement process whereby disputing parties arrive at a mutually acceptable agreement.

WHO CAN MEDIATE:-

Any person who undergoes the required 40 hours training as stipulated by the mediation and Conciliation project committee of the Supreme Court can be a mediator. He also needs to have at least ten mediators resulting in a settlement of at least 20 mediation in all to be eligible to be accredited a qualified mediator.

1) Introduction:- Mediator introduces himself to the parties, explains the mediation process and establishes his neutrality. He explains the ground rules and initiates the Confidential process of dispute resolution.

2) Joint Session:- Mediator gathers information about the factual background and interest of the parties, establishes interaction between them and creates a suitable environment for an "amicable settlement"

3) Individual (Separate) Sessions:- When it becomes necessary, a mediator allows the disputing parties to further explain their grievances. Continues to gather information, persuades individual parties to share information, persuades individual parties to share Confidential information and helps them to create options for an amicable settlement.

4) Agreement:- Mediator confirms and clarifies the terms of settlement and reduces the settlement into a clear, complete, concise and binding agreement.

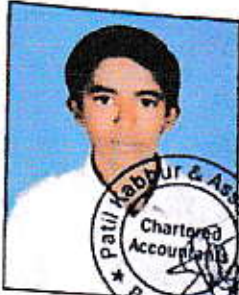

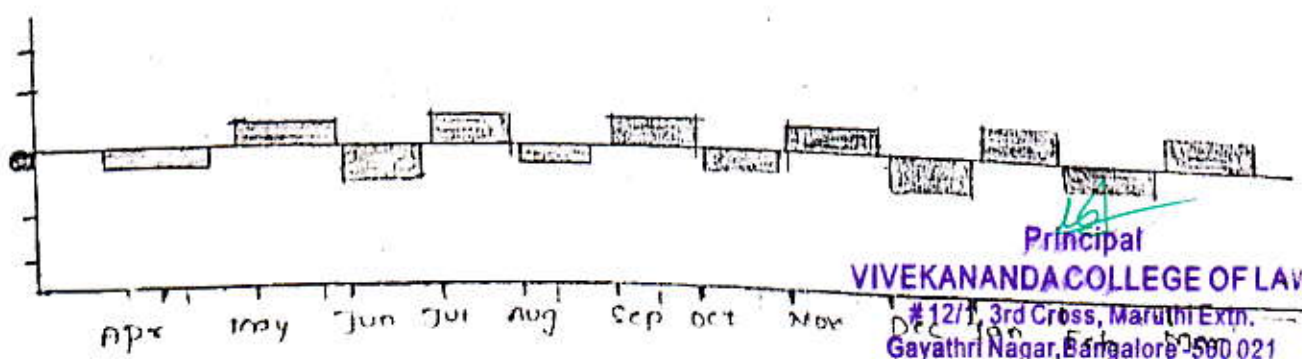

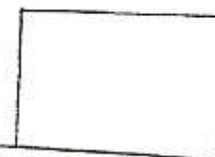

## Contra entry :-

If a debit entry is recorded in an account it will be recorded on the credit side & vice-versa.

## Cash book :-

A cash book is a financial journal that contains all cash receipts & disbursements, including bank deposits & with drawings. Entries in the cash book are then posted into the general ledger.

A tax invoice is an invoice issued by a registered dealer to the purchaser, showing the amount of tax payable. A retail invoice is an invoice issued by the seller to the buyer for the amount due against the goods sold to him.

### Mandatory fields in GST Invoice :-

A Tax Invoice is generally issued to charge the tax and pay a tax credit. A GST Invoice must have the following mandatory fields.

1. Invoice number and date
2. Customer name
3. Shipping & billing address
4. Customer and tax payer's GSTIN (if registered)
5. Place of supply

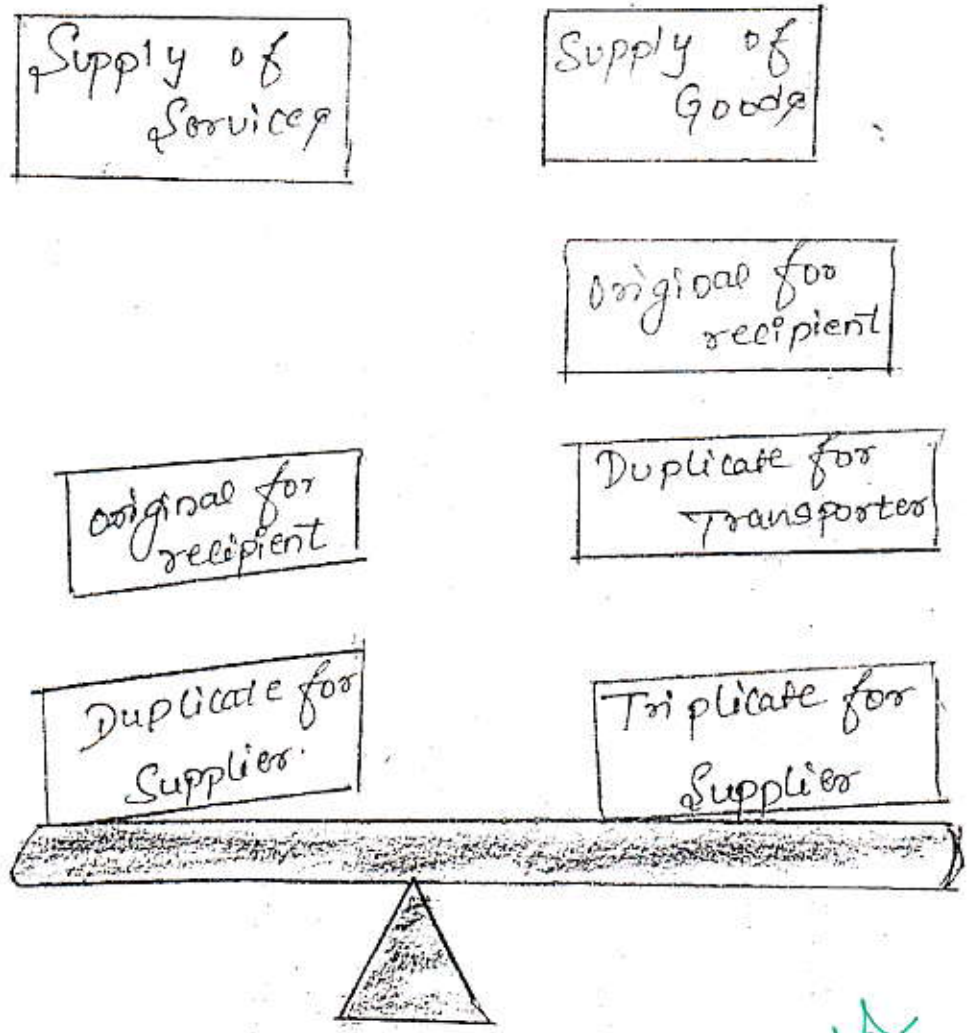

- 7. Item details i.e. description, quantity (Number), unit (meter, kg etc), total value
- 8. Taxable value and discounts
- 9. Rate and amount of taxes i.e. GST / CGST / SGST / IGST

- 11. Signature of the Supplier
