3.4.1 QIM Extension activities are carried out in the neighborhood community, sensitizing students to social issues, for their holistic development, and impact thereof during the last year.

The institution has carried out a number of extension and outreach activities, including Swachhta Abhiyans, Blood donation camps and Legal awareness drives. The extension activities help students in developing a thorough understanding of social issues and afford practical approaches. The college has an active N.S.S. unit (two) and Legal aid cell committed to serving the society. These extension activities have allowed the institution to work in coordination with the society and have given an opportunity to have an insight into social problems that are tormenting the society. These activities also promote a sense of belongingness among the students which brings about a sense of commitment towards the society.

The NSS volunteers have organized various awareness campaigns and have involved the neighbourhood community to participate in all of them. Extension activities help the students to develop problem-solving skills, critical thinking, creativity, communication skills, team work and leadership skills. Overall, these extension activities help the students in developing their skills and knowledge and becoming more responsible and active citizens.
