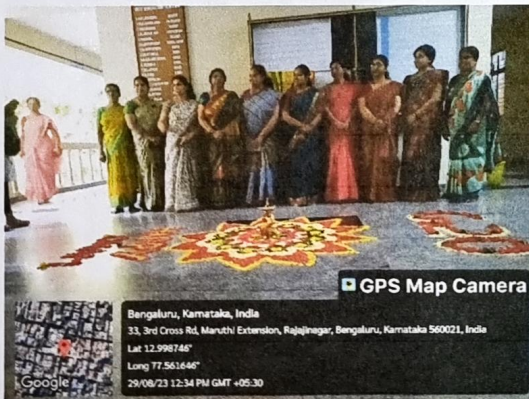

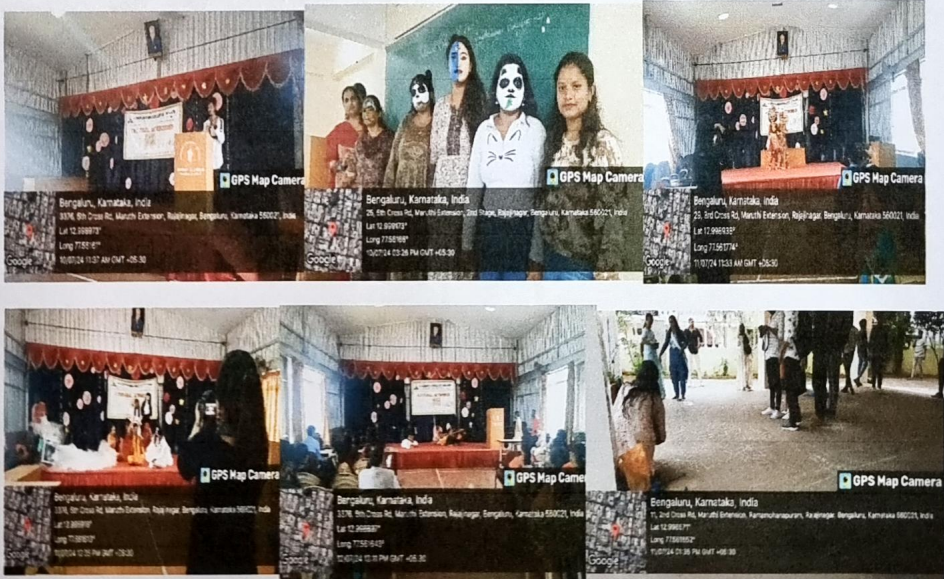


Cultural Fest

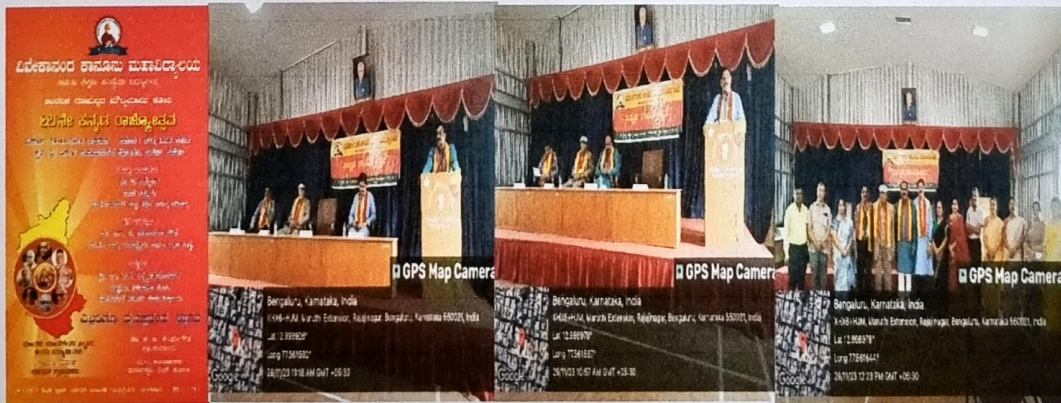
Rajyotsava Day-Academic year 2023-2024

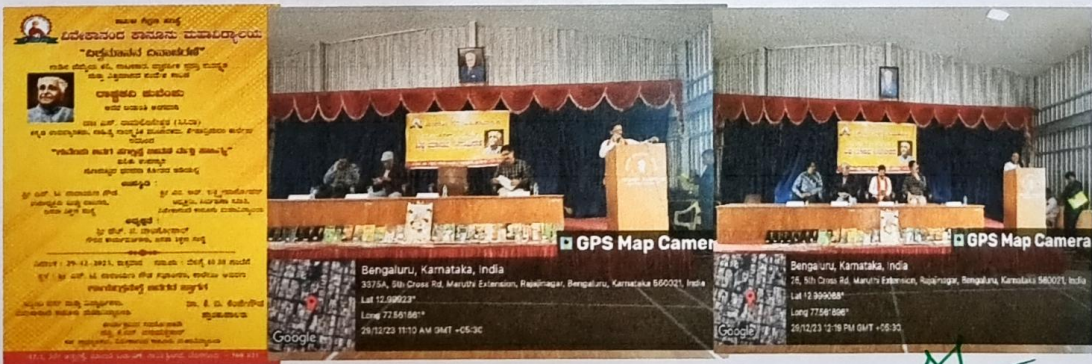
