Annual Report for the Academic Year 2023-24

Good morning dignitaries on the dais, ladies and gentlemen. I am here to present the Annual Report for the Academic Year 2023-24.

- It is a matter of immense pride to state that, our institution is in the 41st year of imparting legal education.
- The institution is affiliated to the **Karnataka State Law University, Hubballi**, which follows the semester system. The **Odd semesters** of the Academic year 2023-24 commenced on **15.11.2023** and ended on **13.03.2024** with examinations held between **21.03.2024** to **27.04.2024**. The **even semesters** commenced from **08.05.2024** and will be ending on **17.08.2024**, with examinations commencing from **21.08.2024** to **17.09.2024**.
- A total number of **667 students** were admitted during the academic year.
